1. Health and Safety Concerns from Coyote Population: Mayor Huguley made a motion to hire a trapper to catch and remove coyotes from Arcadia Lakes after appropriate research is done. Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
2. Dumper Trash and Urgent Need of Service Yard: Mayor Huguley made a motion to move forward with the solicitation of bids for construction of a fence on the towns lot. Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
3. Replacement of Town Limit Signs: Mayor Huguley made a motion for council to accept the renditions for updating the Town of Arcadia Lakes signs using the specifications provided by Mayor Huguley to solicit bids to replace all signs using ARPA funds. Mayor Pro Tem seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. Mayor Huguley also made a motion that council authorize the town clerk or himself to make adjustments on the specifications based on information Council member Peter Chesney provides. Council member Jim Cullen seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
4. Civility Resolution: Mayor Huguley made a motion to approve resolution number 2023-001. Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
5. Website Update: Mayor Huguley made a motion to update the towns website following Burt's recommendations. Linda Jackson seconded the motion, which carried unanimously. Council member Jim Cullen made a second motion to procure using ARPA

funds for the purchase of a wall monitor and equipment necessary to operate it, as well as a quality phone system. Mayor Huguley seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.
