**Approval of Minutes:** Mayor Pro Tem Linda Jackson made a motion to approve the March 22, 2023 Special Called Meeting minutes. Council member Mike Smith seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

1. Possible County Land Use Changes Preceding Meeting: No new information available.
2. Beautification Update: No new information available.
3. AG’s opinion regarding the enforceability of nuisance noise cases made with noise cameras: Deferred to the May 5, 2023 council meeting.
4. Dominion request on town boundaries: No new information available.
5. Updates on Procurements using ARPA Funds:
  - a. Town limit signs: Flag Ship Signs have begun construction of the new town limit signs.
